

2025 New Southbound Taiwan Youth Golf Championship

Competition Regulations

I. Purpose

1. In accordance with the New Southbound Policy, to invite athletes from the New Southbound countries to Taiwan to participate in the event and to promote international relations.
2. To implement Sports Administration's grassroots golf development policy and increase the experience of domestic youth athletes in international competitions.

II. Directed by Sports Administration (Ministry of Education)

III. Organized by National Dong Hwa University

IV. Co-organized by Hualien Tourist Department, Gao Shih Golf Co., Ltd. (San-Ti Group), and Golf Committee (Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation)

V. Competition Date and Venue

1. Date: August 12-14, 2025 (Practice Day: August 11, 2025)
2. Venue: Hualien Golf Club

VI. Competition Categories

1. University Group: For currently enrolled students at the university level or above.
2. Group A: Players aged under 19.
3. Group B: Players aged under 15.
4. Group C: Players aged under 13.
5. Group D: Players aged under 11.

(Each group is further divided by gender, forming a total of ten divisions.)

Note:

For players are eligible for both University Group and Group A may choose to register for either one.

VII. Method of Registration

1. Starting and Ending Dates: From now until Tuesday, July 15, 2025.
2. Entry Fee
 - (1) NT\$2,500 per person.
 - (2) Green fees are self-paid.

6. Method of Payment

Following registration, applicants will receive an electronic payment slip, which can be paid online or at a convenience store.

VIII. Competition Rules

1. The latest rules issued by The R&A, effective January 2023, including seasonal updates and specific local rules approved by the Committee, will be applied. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Committee will be final. Appeals must be made directly to the Tournament Committee.
2. Players must abide by the spirit and etiquette of the game of golf. The use of cell phones or other electronic devices is prohibited during competition. Inappropriate behavior such as foul language, disrupting the play of others, or damaging the course will result in disqualification.
3. If players encounter disputes during the competition and wish to file an appeal, they should contact the Competition Committee, who will assist in completing the appeal process. If an appeal is made, factual evidence must be provided, otherwise it will be considered an improper or malicious accusation and the player will be subject to disqualification.

IX. Competition Format

1. Players must check in 30 minutes prior to their tee time.
2. The competition will be played in a stroke play format over three rounds.
3. Players will score each other and are required to accurately report their opponent's score. Misreporting will result in disqualification.
4. In the event of a tie, the player with the lower final round score will be declared the winner. If the final round score is still tied, the total score for holes 10-18 on the scorecard in the final round will be compared. If there is still a tie, the scores on the scorecard will be compared hole by hole starting with hole 18 and working backwards until a winner is declared.

- XII. Athlete Welcome Banquet: A welcome banquet will be held on August 11, 2025 at 6 p.m. The location will be announced at a later date.
- XIII. Mandatory Rules and Waiver of Claims
1. This competition will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the Player Code of Conduct and the Competition Rules. Players (including guardians, team personnel, etc.) must fully understand their obligations and agree to abide by these rules before registering. By submitting their registration, they acknowledge that they understand and agree to abide by all rules and regulations and cannot claim exemption from them.
 2. In order to maintain the integrity and sportsmanship of the competition, players (including guardians, team personnel, etc.) also agree, by registering, to waive any and all claims against the organizing entities (including, but not limited to, organizers, co-organizers, sanctioning bodies, sponsors, and any other participants). This waiver includes, but is not limited to, any claims for losses incurred during travel or participation in the event, and covers past, present and future losses. However, this does not affect your right to seek legal compensation from insurance companies.
- XIV. Other Matters
1. In the event of a dispute during the competition, the referee's decision is final.
 2. In case of inclement weather, the organizer may adjust, postpone or cancel the competition as he deems necessary.
 3. The grouping lists will be posted on the website of the Physical Education Center (National Dong Hwa University), the Facebook page of the Physical Education Center (National Dong Hwa University).
